A gable end facing the street with a large single double hung, in a shallow bay, as the principal window. A cross gable runs parallel to the street with a shed roof porch infilling the corner. The porch has been infilled, and the entry brought out to the façade. A small gable sits above the door, with a sunburst siding pattern. A pair of full height casement windows sit adjacent to the door. A gable dormer roof sits on top of the original ridge line, with a rectangular vent window. The house has horizontal wood siding with scalloped shingles infilling the gable ends.
